The father of lies hasn't changed much since Genesis 3. The tactics Satan used against Adam and Eve are the same tactics he still uses to lead people into sexual sin every day.

Use this chart to help you identify the 27 tactics Satan used on Adam and Eve and will use on you when he tempts you with pornography — and to learn specific strategies for resisting each one.



This chart of tactics is drawn from the sermons, *Developing Sales Resistance Parts 1-5*, where Dr. Kayser goes through each tactic and how to resist them in more much detail.
